

How to install (English)

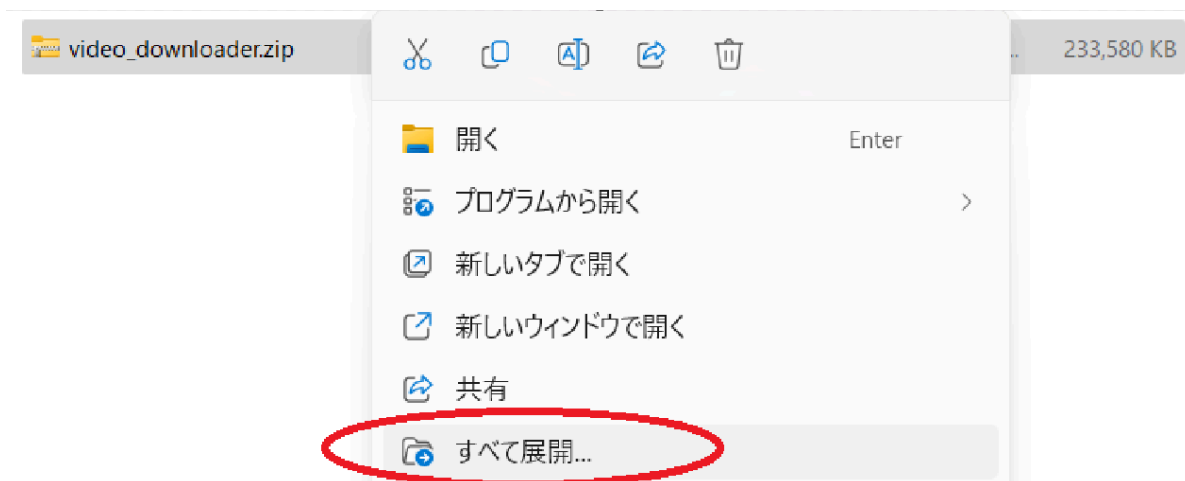
Overview: Video Downloader

- This software lets you easily download videos from a URL.
- For detailed instructions, see the “How to use” section.

How to install

- Installation can be done in 2 simple steps.

1. Extract (unzip) the downloaded ZIP file.



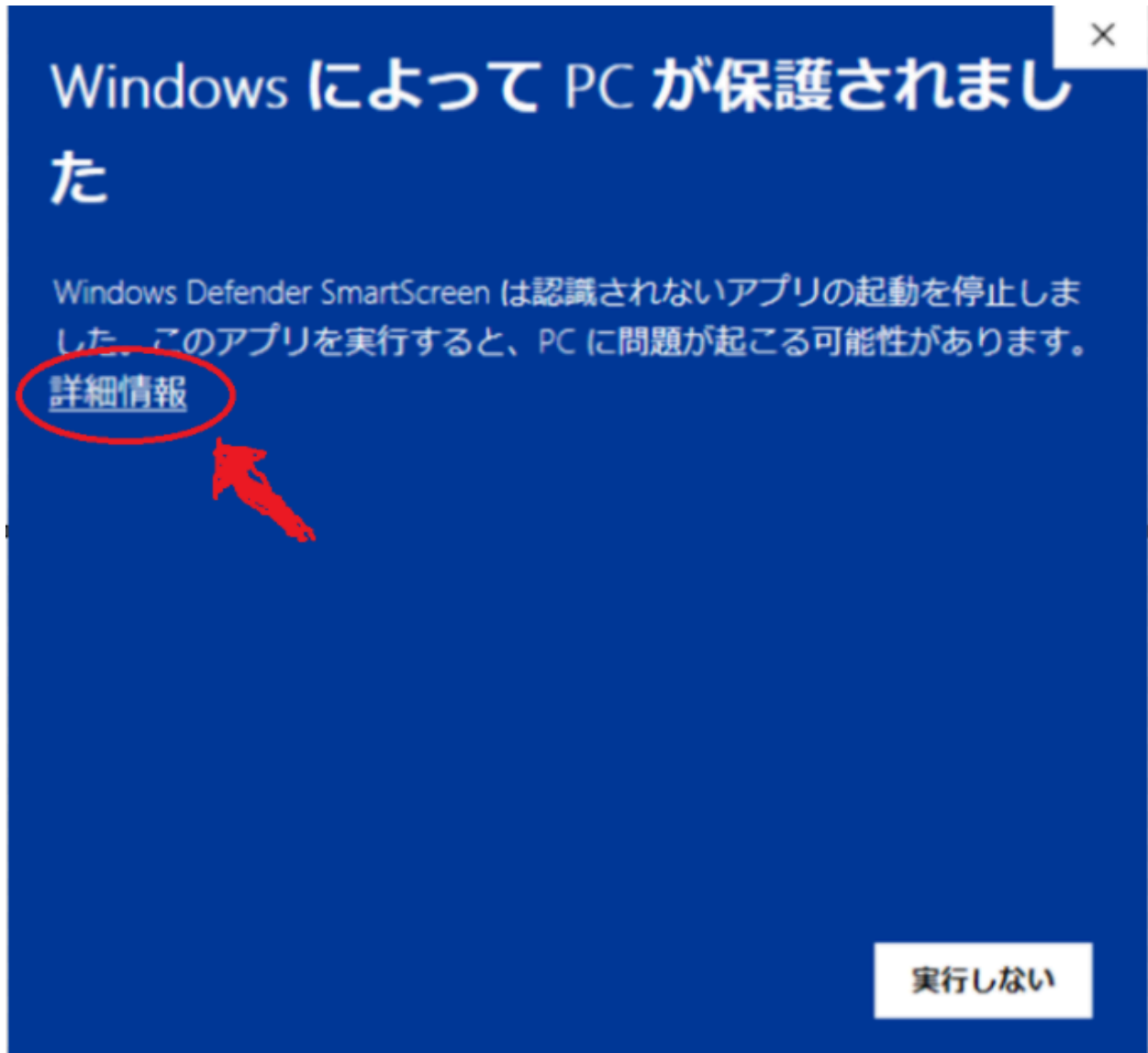
2. Click the .msi file.

The file “VideoDownloader_0.1.0_x64_en-US.msi” is inside the extracted folder.

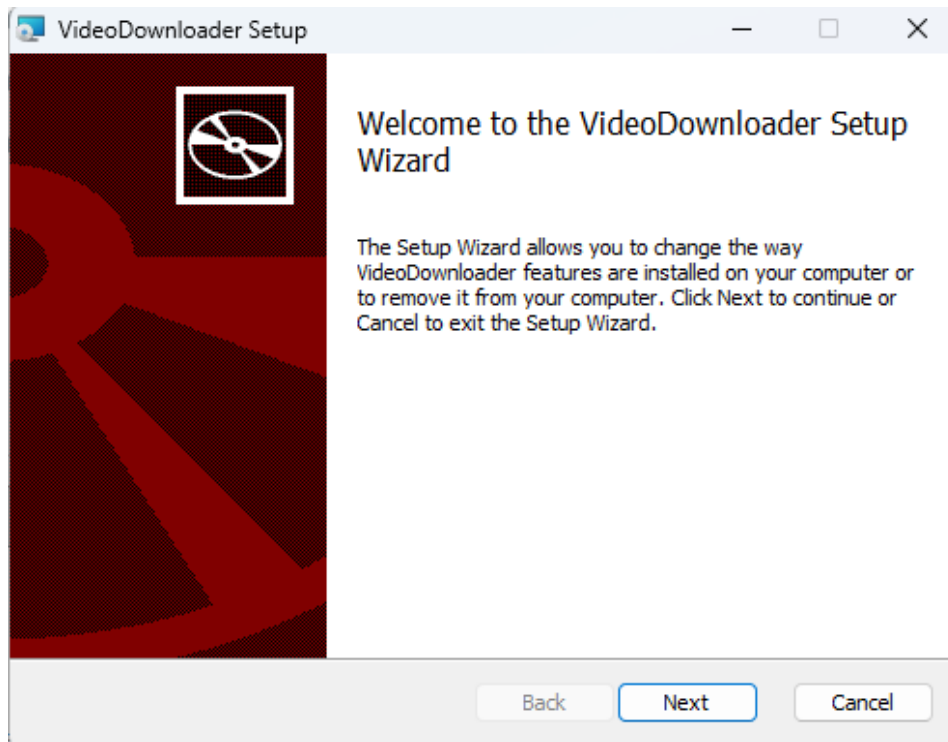


- Clicking it will start the installation.
If a warning like the one below appears, click “More info” and then choose

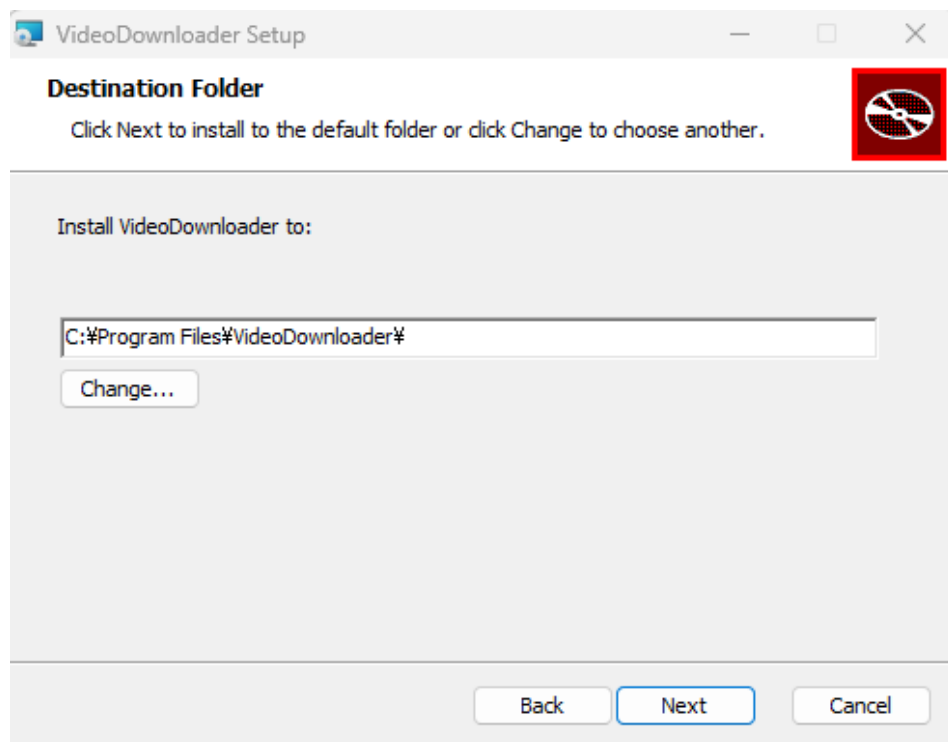
"Run anyway".



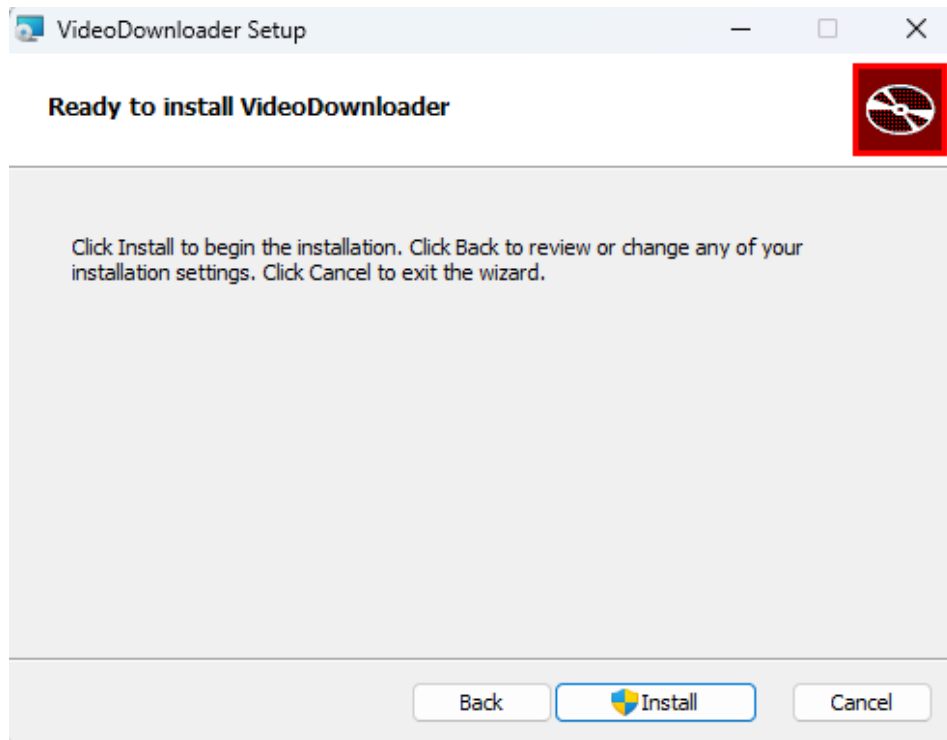
- The installer will appear. Click **Next** to proceed.



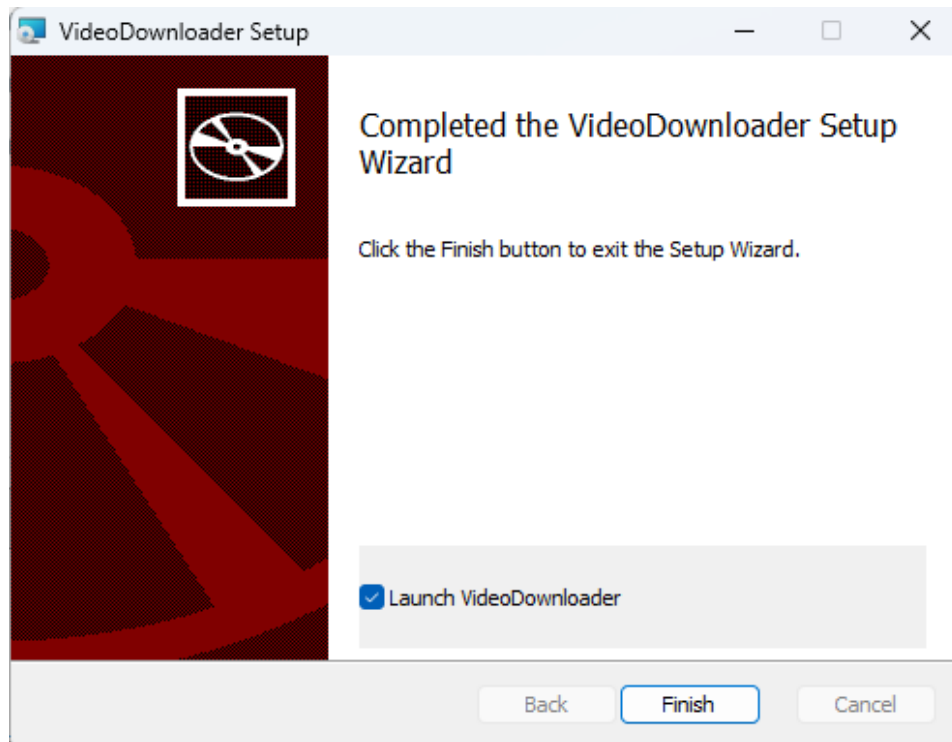
- You will be asked to choose an install location. Leave it as-is and click **Next**.



- Click **Install** to start the installation.



- During installation, you may be asked for administrator privileges. Please click **OK** to continue.
- When it's finished, click **Finish** to launch the app.



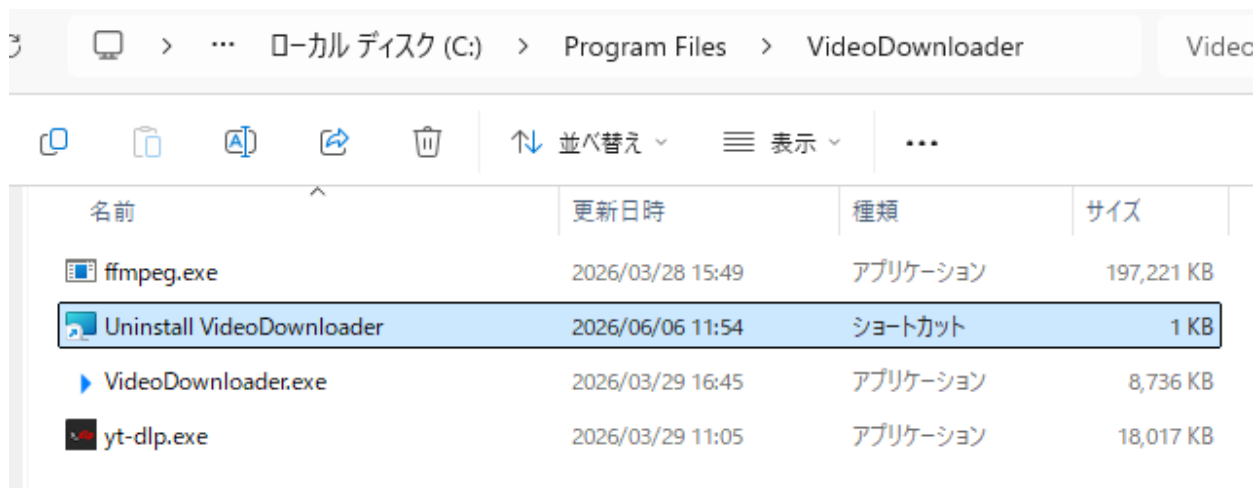
- A shortcut will be added to your desktop. You can also launch it from there.



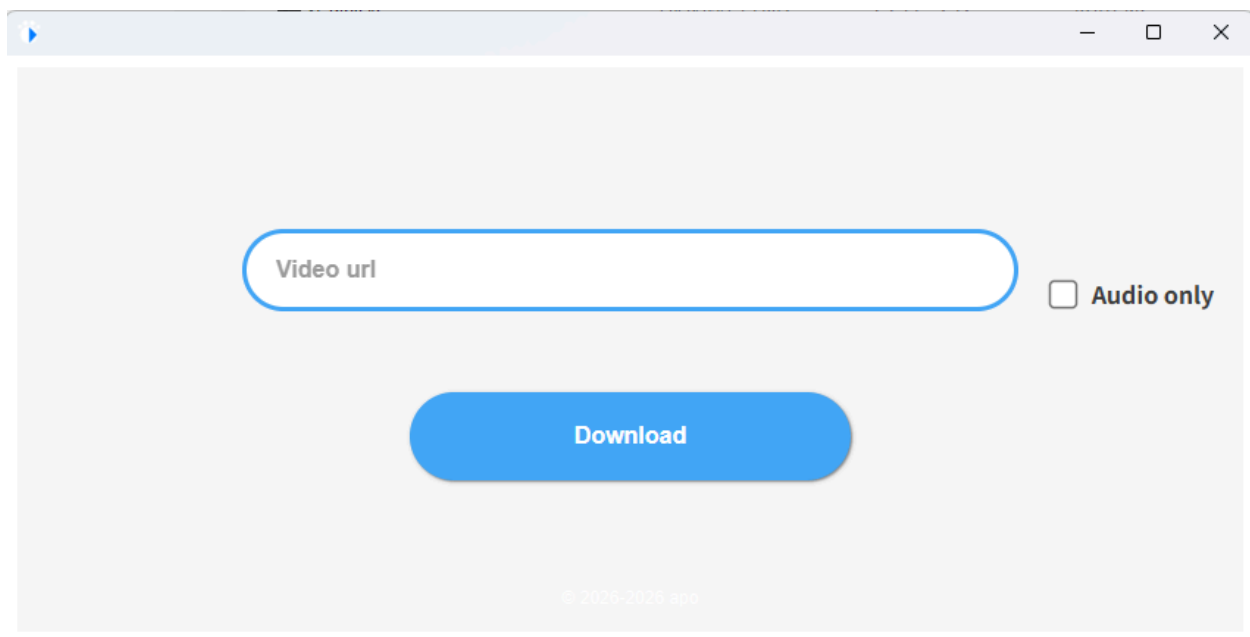
- That's all.

How to uninstall

- Click **Uninstall VideoDownloader** in `C:\\Program Files\\VideoDownloader` to uninstall.



How to use



- Copy the video URL and paste it into the URL box.
- Click the **Download** button.

Options

- If you check **Audio only**, you can download only the audio.

Notes

- This software currently works on Windows only.
- The video format depends on the source platform, and the audio format is MP3 only at the moment. If you would like other formats supported, please feel free to contact the author.

Distribution type

- Freeware (free to use).

System requirements

- Confirmed to work on Windows 10 Home and Windows 11 only. (If there is demand, a Mac version may be supported in the future.)
